In today's world of shared information, Precision Wireless Internet (PWI) takes great care of protecting your personal information as well as ours. Please read the following privacy statement to learn how our company handles information about you.

I. Information Collection

PWI is the sole owner of the information collected on the PWI web site. PWI may collect information from visitors to the web sites ("users") at different places on the PWI web sites in order to provide services to the users and to improve such services.

USER REGISTRATION

During registration a User is required to provide contact information (such as name, mailing address, telephone numbers, and email address). PWI uses this information to maintain contact with the User as is necessary pursuant to the subscription agreement. Users may also provide financial information (such as credit card number, expiration date) when subscribing to the PWI service. This information is used for billing and payment purposes. In the event PWI has trouble processing an order, that information is used to contact the User.

II. Information Use

LOG FILES

Like most standard web site servers, PWI's web sites uses log files. PWI may collect and store information from log files that are remotely stored in the possession of PWI in a secure encrypted file. This may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses, etc. are not linked to personally identifiable information. IP addresses may be tied to personally identifiable information to enable web-based services. To manage user accounts and for other purposes, we may use tracking tools and utilities such as grep, traceroute, host, nslookup, or others.

III. Communications from PWI

SPECIAL OFFERS AND UPDATES

PWI may send new Users a welcoming email to verify password, username, and acceptance of the Subscription/User Agreement. Users may occasionally receive information on products, services, special deals, and the like offered by PWI.

SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

On rare occasions it is necessary to send out a strictly service related announcement. For instance, if our service is temporarily suspended for maintenance PWI may send an email notifying Users of the outage. Generally, Users may not opt-out of these communications, though they can deactivate their account. These communications are not promotional in nature.

PWI SERVICE

PWI communicates with Users via email, regular mail and telephone on a regular basis to provide requested services and regarding issues related to User's services.

IV. Sharing

LEGAL DISCLAIMER

PWI DOES NOT Share Personal Information about users with any Third Parties except to provide services requested by our Users.

Though PWI makes every effort to preserve user privacy, PWI may need to disclose personal information when required by law when it has a good-faith belief that such action is necessary to comply with a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process served on PWI.

AGGREGATE INFORMATION (NON-PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE)

PWI may share aggregated demographic information with partners or advertisers. This is not linked to any personally identifiable information.

SERVICE PROVIDERS

PWI may partner with third parties to provide specific services used by our Users. In such event, PWI may share names or other contact information with such parties so that they may provide services such as technical support to users. Third parties are not allowed to use personally identifiable information except for the purpose of providing these services.

BUSINESS TRANSITIONS

In the event PWI goes through a business transition, such as a merger, being acquired by another company, or selling a portion of its assets, the personal information of PWI's users will, in most instances, be part of the assets transferred. Users will be notified prior to a change of use of their personal information. If as a result of the business transition, a user's personally identifiable information will be used in a manner different from that stated at the time of collection the user will be given the following choice consistent with our notification of changes section.

CHOICE

Users are always notified when their information is being collected by any outside parties. We do this so users can make an informed choice as to whether or not they should proceed with services that require an outside party.

LINKS

PWI's web sites may contain links to other sites. Please be aware that PWI is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. We encourage users to be aware when they leave our site and to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by PWI's web sites.

SECURITY

PWI takes every precaution to protect all users' information. When users submit sensitive information via PWI's web sites, their information is protected both online and off-line.

When the User End User Agreement or other online forms ask users to enter sensitive information (such as credit card number and/or social security number), that information is encrypted and is protected with the best encryption software in the industry - SSL. While on a secure page, such as the User End User Agreement and online order forms, the lock icon either on the bottom or top of web browsers such as Apple Safari, Mozilla Firefox and Microsoft Internet Explorer becomes locked, as opposed to un-locked, or open, when users are just 'surfing'.

While PWI uses SSL encryption to protect sensitive information online, the Company also does everything in our power to protect user information off-line. All user information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in PWI's offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to personally identifiable information. ALL employees are kept up-to-date on Company security and privacy practices. Finally, the servers that store personally identifiable information are in a secure environment.
